Geldof to visit for talkfest

YOU would think **Bob Geldof's** hands would be full nursing drug-addled teen daughter **Peaches** back to health.

But the human rights activist is leaving the family home in London to speak at a business awards ceremony in Melbourne.

The former Boom Town Rats frontman has been announced as a keynote speaker at the eighth annual Diversity@Work Awards, which will be held at Crown Palladium on November 13.

The trip Down Under would be a good chance to bring step-daughter **Heavenly Hiraani Tiger Lily Hutchence** to see her grandparents in NSW.

Tiger Lily is the daughter of Geldof's late ex-wife **Paula Yates**, who died of a heroin overdose in 2000, and rock legend **Michael Hutchence**.

Hutchence's mother **Patricia Glassop** is not crossing her fingers for a visit.

Glassop has routinely fired pot shots at Geldof over the years, claiming he has banned her from seeing Tiger Lily, 12.

Glassop said she was gripped by an "overwhelming sadness" when she heard Peaches was hospitalised after a suspected drug overdose on Sunday.

Peaches, 19, was allegedly given mouth-to-mouth by a friend when she collapsed.

"I said to my husband, 'Now we really have to be concerned', but what can we do?" Glassop said. "Bob won't let us have any contact with Tiger at all.

"I just have to hope she doesn't become like Peaches, because she is just a fright.

"But this news is very sad and I feel so sorry for her because when it comes to drug dependency, she is obviously like her mother."
